Harrison Mills is bordered on three sides by water and has endured many floods in the past. The ramps and elevated boardwalks, built to stay above the floodwaters, gave Harrison Mills its unique architecture. At the bottom of the Main Ramp, the Oil House and gas pumps wait for the return of the Model A. Walking through the front door of the 1906 General Store is like entering a time capsule. The original shelves are crowded with the necessities of life from the 1920s. A friendly storekeeper is waiting to show you around and pass the time with a story or two. The **Fraser Heritage Society** is a charitable, non-profit society. Your admission to museum helps the Society to preserve the history of this unique site for future generations. We encourage you to consider purchasing a season's pass to support the Society and their endeavours. A Season's Pass includes unlimited entry to the museum, farm & events for one full calendar year. Family \$60, Adults \$22 & Seniors \$20.

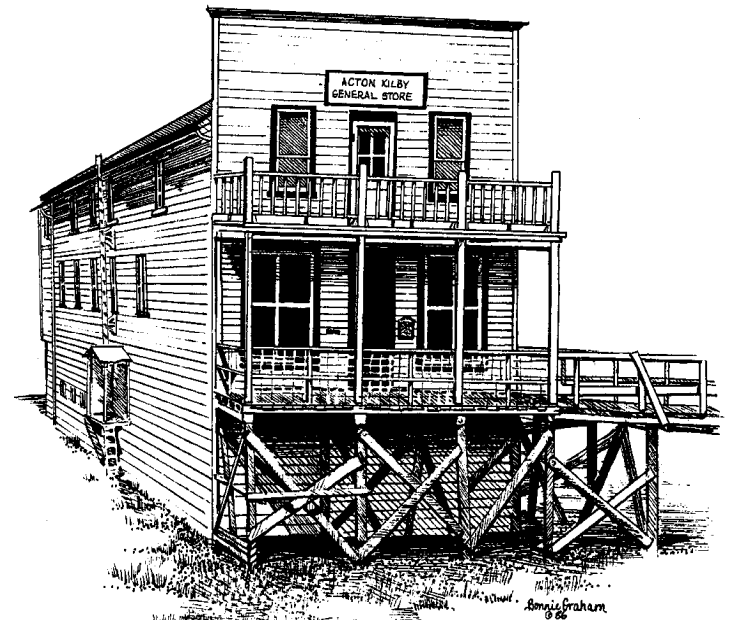
No matter when you purchase your Season Pass it is valid for one full calendar year.

Located on the confluence of the Harrison and Fraser Rivers, the **Kilby Historic Site** stands as the only reminder of the once thriving community of Harrison Mills. This 5 acre BC Heritage site includes a visit to our working farm filled with friendly animals and orchard playground.

Within walking distance of the museum is the scenic **Kilby Park** located on the Harrison River.
