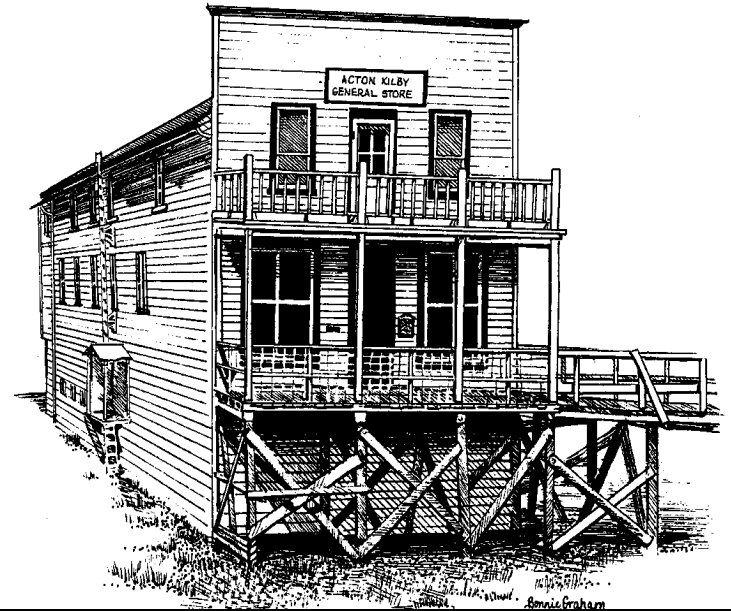
No matter when you purchase your Season Pass it is valid for one full calendar year.
