

Kilby Park

Kilby Park is situated on the confluence of the Harrison and Fraser rivers, just down the road from the museum. The park features a beautiful 35-site waterfront campground complete with sandy beaches, nature trails and boat launch.



Did you know? Educational School Programming is offered year-round! Lock, Stock and Cracker Barrel - (K - Grade 3) and 1920s Heritage Tour (for all ages) Our friendly, costumed interpreters will lead a fun and highly interactive program that explores the operation of a 1920s general store and farm in a rural Canadian community. Additional experiences includes an Ice Cream making or Apple Pressing demonstration, or a heritage walking tour. In this walking tour, students learn about Harrison Mills and the surrounding area's unique culture. The students will be introduced to our region's geography and industry. Archival photographs will reveal the need for the extensive dyking system in place today.

Kilby Historic Site is operated by a charitable non-profit with a volunteer board. Your admission for these events goes towards the sustainability of the site for future generations.
