**1 Student Position Vacancy:  
Heritage Interpreter, Actor  
(Young Canada Works Program)**

Looking for the best 12 week summer job ever? The Kilby Historic Site is seeking two creative youth who have an interest in history, enjoy working with children and adults, and have a passion for the dramatic! Under the guidance of the Program Director, the Heritage Interpreter/Actor position will engage visitors in immersive interpretations using a variety of artistic methods. The Kilby Historic Site is a designated provincial historic site operated by a charitable non-profit society in rural BC.

**June 2 to August 25, 2022**

Please note that the staffing of the position and its duration are conditional on the approval of the grant application submitted to the Young Canada Works program. This position offers \$16.25 an hour and up to 35 hrs a week.

**Duties include:**

- Conduct engaging and thought-provoking guided tours, demonstrations, and programs.
- Develop 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century historically-based vignettes telling the story of Harrison Mills, an early rural community in BC.
- Wear a supplied costume while on site.
- Develop and teach engaging and relevant lesson plans for Kilby's Behind the Gate theatre camp for children 8 -12 years old.
- Coordinate and teach Kilby Campers morning sessions – twice a week in July
- Ensures program items are well maintained and appropriately stored. Assists with creation of props.
- Demonstrate excellent customer service skills
- Attend to all site opening and closing routines; and security of museum artefacts.

**Requirements include:**

- Under the Guidelines of this program to be eligible: youth must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act. You must be legally entitled to work in Canada. You must be between 15 & 30 years of age at the start of employment
- Have registered as a full-time\* student in the semester preceding the job (\*as defined by their educational institution) Intend to return to full-time studies in the semester immediately following the job. Not have another full-time job (over 30 hours a week) while employed; and be registered in the YCW online candidate inventory [www.young-canada-works.canada.ca](http://www.young-canada-works.canada.ca)
- Outgoing personality with strong public speaking skills.
- The ideal candidate will have completed a year of study in theatre, education, history, museum studies or a related program. Previous acting experience preferred.
- Experience working with children and youth.
- Ability to work collaborately and independently
- Driver's license not required but must possess a reliable means of transportation to/from work
- Ability to pass a Vulnerable Sector Criminal Records Check required
