The Kilby Historic Site is seeking creative youth who have an interest in history, enjoy working with adults and children and have a passion for the dramatic! Under the guidance of the Program Director, the Museum Interpreter position will engage visitors in sharing the history of a rural community in Harrison Mills. The Kilby Historic Site is a designated provincial historic site operated by a charitable non-profit society in rural BC. **June 30 – August 25, 2022.**

Please note this is a Canada Summer Job program and the candidate must meet eligibility guidelines listed below.

Duties include:

- With full training, conduct engaging and thought-provoking guided tours, demonstrations, and programs.
- Wear a supplied costume while on site.
- Ensure program items are well maintained and appropriately stored.
- Demonstrate excellent customer service skills
- Attend to all site opening and closing routines; and security of museum artefacts.
- Perform other related duties.

Requirements include:

- Under the Guidelines of this program to be eligible: you must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment; be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act²; and, be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations..
- Demonstrated public speaking experience
- Theatre or drama experience a strong asset.
- Ability to work co-operatively, as part of a team
- Ability to work 35 hours a week including weekends.
- Driver's license not required but must possess a reliable means of transportation to/from work
- Priority may be given to applications from our surrounding towns and First Nations communities
- Must be able to pass and maintain a criminal and personal record background check.
