Junior Merchants gr. 1 - 4

\$11 per student plus GST (90 minutes)

Step into an original 1906 General Store and Hotel to uncover the role it played in early communities. Students will become junior merchants and help fill a grocery order. Hands-on learning at its best!

Harrison Homesteaders gr. 3-6

Experience a day in the life of a homesteading child. Step into the role of a child from 1906 where there is always work to be done. From tin piercing to biscuit shaping and butter churning, these hands-on activities will illustrate the challenges in the everyday lives of children living in Harrison Mills. *Classes are encouraged to dress up in period clothing.*

Charlotte's Fur Trade gr.4, gr.9

\$32/student, 8 visits (90 minutes per visit)
