The Kilby Historic Site is seeking creative person who have an interest in culture, enjoy working with adults and children and have a passion for learning. Under the guidance of the Program Director, the Museum Interpreter positions will engage visitors in sharing the history of a rural community in Harrison Mills. The Kilby Historic Site is a designated provincial historic site operated by a charitable non-profit society in rural BC.

This 8-week summer job offers many opportunities to learn cross discipline skills
from **July 3rd to August 25th, 2025**

Duties include:

- Conduct engaging and thought-provoking guided tours.
- Conduct demonstrations and programs such a butter making, tin piercing and more.
- Wear a supplied costume while on site.
- Ensure program items are well maintained and appropriately stored.
- Demonstrate excellent customer service skills.
- Attend to all site opening and closing routines, and security of museum artifacts.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Weekend work is expected.
- Perform other related duties.

Requirements include:

- Under the Guidelines of this program to be eligible: you must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment; be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act 2; and, be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Demonstrated public speaking experience
- Theatre or drama experience a strong asset.
- Ability to work co-operatively, as part of a team
- Ability to work 35 hours a week including weekends.
- Driver's license not required but must possess a reliable means of transportation to/from work
- Must be able to pass and maintain a criminal and personal record background check.
