## Kilby Park Campground General Information and Rules

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Reservations open February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026 Tuesday - Thursday 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. There are 34 reservable sites and 7 first come, first served sites. Please see the campground map.
2. Main campground is open March 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.
3. Reservations can be made 4 months in advance of desired date. You may book your stay up to 14 days beyond the rolling window as long as the starting date of your stay falls within the rolling window (i.e., if you want to make a reservation for July 20<sup>th</sup>, reservation can be made on March 20<sup>th</sup>).
4. 24-HOUR ONLINE RESERVATIONS: <https://kilby.ca/campground/>. Please click on the "RESERVE CAMPSITE ONLINE" button.
5. RESERVATION DESK HOURS: Tuesday to Thursday 10:00 am to 2:00 pm, opening Tuesday February 17<sup>th</sup> to June 18<sup>th</sup>. Call 604-796-9576 and follow the prompts (\$5 phone reservation fee will apply).
6. Full payment (including reservation fees) is required at time of booking via credit card only.
7. NO reservations will be accepted via email or phone message.
8. If you need to change your reservation, please contact our reservation desk at 604-796-9576 Ext.105. A change fee of \$15 will apply.
9. **NO double or multiple bookings.** One reservation per person (i.e., one person cannot book multiple sites). **Penalty:** Any campers reserving multiple sites within the same dates will be contacted by administration to cancel the additional reservations. Reservations must be made by the individual occupying the site.

#### MAXIMUM LENGTH OF STAY

To create more opportunities for a greater number of park visitors each person (whether or not they are the registered permit holder) may only camp up to a maximum of 14 nights from June 15<sup>th</sup> to September 7<sup>th</sup> (Labour Day).

## MINIMUM LENGTH OF STAY

### Long Weekends

- Long weekend (statutory holiday) reservations have a **3-night minimum** reservation. (Friday, Saturday, **AND** Sunday night).

### High Season Weekends

- High Season Weekend reservations have a **2-night minimum** reservation (Friday night and Saturday night).

## RESERVATION RULES

- **No reservations or cancellations will be accepted by email or voicemail.**
- If you need to change your reservation, please call our reservation line at 604-796-9576 and follow the prompts. A change fee of \$15 will apply.
- **NO double or multiple bookings allowed.** One reservation per person. Any campers reserving multiple sites within the same dates will be contacted by administration and may have their additional reservations cancelled.
- The registered adult (permit holder, who must be 19 years or older) becomes the designated representative for the campsite and must provide ID, vehicle license number(s), and the makeup of people in their campsite upon check-in. This adult is responsible for the actions of all members of their campsite and any visitors to the campsite. For this reason, please be advised that **if a guest arrives before the registered permit holder, they will need to wait to check in.**
- **Reservations/sites are not transferable.** The reservation permit holder's name must be provided at the time of booking and cannot be added or changed later. Any reservation holders found to be transferring or selling their reservations to another party risk their reservations being cancelled without a refund. If a permit holder can no longer use their reservation, they are encouraged to cancel it so that any unused camping fees (that are not forfeited as a penalty) can be refunded.
- Damages to the campground and equipment by any member of your camping party must be reported and be paid for. Damages found after your camping party has vacated the campground will remain the responsibility of your camping party. Management will contact you for prompt payment.

## LIMITED OCCUPANCY

- The number of people per campsite is **EIGHT**, of which four adults are allowed, **including** daytime visitors.









## VEHICLES PER CAMPSITE

- Please note, guests may not reserve a campsite for additional vehicles, trailers, boats, or any other non-accommodation vehicle.
- Only one camping unit (trailer/camper/RV/tent) and one vehicle (car/truck) are allowed per site, except in the case of a second tent (see tent policy below).
- These are acceptable camping units per campsite:
  - a motor vehicle towing a trailer designed as an accommodation for camping, e.g., fifth wheel, travel trailer, tent trailer; or
  - a recreational vehicle (RV), e.g., motor home, camperized truck/van; or
  - an RV with a legally towed motor vehicle; or
  - a motor vehicle or RV towing a trailer not designed as an accommodation for camping, e.g. utility/cargo or boat trailer
- **Tent Policy:** One tent may accompany any of the above vehicles, or if tenting only, 2 tents per site maximum.
- The number of passenger vehicles (i.e. cars, SUVs, and trucks) in a campsite must not exceed 2 at any time. Please note that the second passenger vehicle requires a permit for overnight stay (\$15/night).

## VEHICLES & PARKING











- With approval of the park attendant, a campsite may be allowed one additional motor vehicle (not designed as an accommodation) for an additional fee of \$15 per night.
- All motorcycles qualify as extra vehicles.
- All vehicles and trailers, of whatever type, must be within the boundaries of their respective site. No parking at all on the roadway or grassy area. Please use the gravel pad.
- Parking in the day use area is at your own risk. We are not responsible for personal injury, loss, or damage to vehicles, equipment, or contents.
- **When a boat trailer is towed in by a single vehicle or RV there is no additional charge (tow vehicle exemption: see below). There is, however, a \$15 fee if your RV or truck (primary vehicle) leaves and returns with a boat trailer and you already have an RV, trailer, or tow vehicle on-site.**

NO SHOWS

- Reservations are held until 11:00 am the day after the scheduled arrival date. After this time, all fees will be forfeited, and the site will be made available to other visitors. If you can't make your arrival date, please call the reservation line at 604-796-9576 to cancel or make the appropriate changes. If you are confirming a late arrival, you can email us at [campground@kilby.ca](mailto:campground@kilby.ca).
- You will receive a courtesy call before the site is released. **Please ensure we have the correct phone number on file.**

#### CANCELLING A RESERVATION

- If a reservation cannot be fulfilled, the permit holder should cancel their reservation at least 14 days in advance to receive a 100% refund (minus the \$15 cancellation fee) or risk charges as laid out in the cancellation guidelines below.
- **NEW:** All cancellations must be made through the Reservation Desk. Call 604-796-9576 Ext.105. Please note that your reservation is **not cancelled until you speak with one of our staff** on the reservation line.
- **NEW:** LONG WEEKEND CANCELLATIONS: If you are cancelling a reservation over a long weekend less than 14 days prior to the first day of your reservation, all fees are forfeited.

#### CHECKING IN WITH A RESERVATION

- Check-in starts at 1:00 pm; please check in at the gatehouse before heading to your site.
- Check-out time is 11:00 am. Late check-outs may be subject to a late check-out charge.
- There is a \$10 site-change fee if you want to move to a different site after check-in. This must be confirmed by a park attendant. Our ability to accommodate such changes is subject to availability and will be limited during the peak season. Please note: A confirmed reservation cannot be transferred to a first come, first served campsite.
- If you wish to extend your stay after you check in, please see campground staff on site.

#### FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED (FCFS)

- There are 7 designated FCFS sites. Upon arrival, find an unoccupied FCFS site and leave your camping unit at your site to hold your place. Pick up an envelope at the boat launch, follow the instructions, and we will check in with you during your stay.
- A camping unit means an RV or tent (sleeping accommodation). Chairs, coolers, easy ups, etc. are not acceptable place holders.
- Check-out time is 11:00 am. Late check-outs may be subject to a late check-out charge.
- There is a \$10 site-change fee if you want to move to a different site after check-in. This must be confirmed by a park attendant. Our ability to accommodate such changes is subject to availability and will be limited during the peak season. Please note: A confirmed reservation cannot be transferred to a first come, first served campsite.

#### VISITORS

- VISITOR HOURS: 7:00 am - 10:00 pm. Visitors must leave the park by 10:00 pm to avoid disturbing campers.

- VISITOR PARKING OPTIONS: 1) Visitors may park at the permit holder's campsite provided there are no more than 2 vehicles total at the campsite; 2) Visitors may park at day use until 10:00 pm.

## ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

The following behaviours are not permitted and will result in **immediate removal from the campground without refund**:

- Harassment, intimidation, threats, or violence to staff & fellow campers
- Excessive noise or disruptive behaviour, particularly during quiet hours
- Drinking or smoking outside registered campsite
- Dog off leash in any area of the park (including in the water)
- Unsafe or dangerous behaviour, including illegal fires or ignoring fire restrictions
- Vandalism, theft, or damage to campground property or natural areas
- Failure to comply with staff instructions related to safety or campground operations
- Illegal activity of any kind

## PETS

- For the safety of other dogs and small children, pets must be **on a leash at all times**: at your campsite, on the beach, in the water and in public areas. This means that pets must be leashed and/or tethered. You must have your leash in-hand and have control of the animal. The leash may be no more than 8 feet as per bylaw.
- Please clean up after your pet.

## NOISE

- Excessive noise is not cool at any time! Please remember that sound travels further in open air, especially music and loud talking. We may ask you to turn down your music or other sources of noise at our discretion.
- QUIET TIME: Quiet time is from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Please keep noise at a minimum between these hours. Only registered campers are allowed in the campground between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- GENERATOR USE: Generator use is only permitted from 9:00 am to 11:00 am and from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. The use of "inverted generators" (i.e., low noise generators) are preferred. Generators must be placed within your campsite. Generators must be kept on your site's gravel pad at all times. Please refer to our campground policies document for the full generator policy.
- IDLING: No idling of vehicles within your campsite or on the campground roadway. Please refer to our campground policies document for the full idling policy.

## ALCOHOL

- Consumption is restricted to **registered campsites only** and responsible use is expected.
- Not allowed in any public areas including roads, day use area, washrooms, and beach as per the liquor control and licensing act (LCLA 73.1).
- Public intoxication or threats to public safety or staff will not be tolerated. Please consider your fellow campers.

## SMOKING

- For the safety and enjoyment of all visitors and to protect the park, smoking and vaping are only permitted within your designated campsite. Please be sensitive to your neighbours.

## CAMPFIRES

- Firewood is available for sale at the gatehouse. \$12 per bundle or 3 bundles for \$32.
- No fires of any kind on the beach.

- No cutting or removal of trees, shrubs, grass, flowers, etc. Deadwood from the park is not to be used for firewood. Driftwood may be used if it fits into the fire pit.
- Absolutely no burning of pallets, treated wood, or any wood containing screws, nails, or industrial staples.
- Please do not move fire pits. You must use the designated fire ring provided. The only exception is an enclosed woodstove.

## BOAT LAUNCH

- If you are camping and have a boat, there will be a one-time fee of \$15 to launch. Your boat trailer must be parked on your campsite or in the boat launch area with receipt displayed. There will be a \$15 fee per night to keep your trailer on-site. See the chart on page three. If you have any questions, please check with a park attendant.

## CHALK, PAINT, AND WATER BALLOONS

- For the safety of the environment water balloons, paint, and chalk are **BANNED** from Kilby Campground.

## FIREWORKS, FIREARMS, HUNTING, AND DRONES

- No hunting, shooting, or handling of firearms of any kind.
- Absolutely no fireworks or drones of any kind.

## OFF-ROAD VEHICLES

- No off-road or unlicensed vehicles are to be operated in or near the park.
- No unlicensed driver may operate a vehicle in the park.

## BEACH USE

- Absolutely **NO** tents, wood fires, propane fires, or BBQs allowed on the beach.
- Dogs **must** remain on leash for the safety of other dogs and small children.
- Clean up after your pet.

## HOUSEKEEPING

- Keep the toilets clean and do not put garbage, bottles, or cans in the toilets.
- Please sort and recycle glass, plastic bottles, pop, and beer cans in the recycling bins provided. All income generated from recycled materials will be used for animal care at the Kilby Historic Site.
- Do not put garbage in the recycling bin.
- Entrails and other waste from cleaning fish are not to be disposed of in the park or on the beach. This will attract wildlife. A fed bear is a dead bear.
- Wood is \$12 per bundle or 3 bundles for \$32.
- Ice is \$6 per bag or 3 bags for \$16. Bags of ice are 2.3 kg and are made from Kilby water!

## EMERGENCIES & SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

- Please record and report anything out of the ordinary to the park operator and/or the RCMP.
- **For emergencies call 911.**

*Failure to comply with park policies may result in enforcement action, including cancellation of your camping permit and/or eviction from the park. Park attendants have full discretion, and admittance may be refused.*

*This park is owned by the Province of BC and managed by the Kilby Heritage Society, a charitable, non-profit organization that also operates the adjacent Kilby Historic Site. While we generally align with BC Parks rules, some services and facilities may differ.*
